Looking at local production, Lettuce and most Greens, of course, are done for the season. As for the imported Lettuce, coming mostly from California, it has been very scarce and costly due to weather and disease challenges. So, for now, you will be seeing no Lettuce in your veggie boxes. This is truly the time to embrace our wonderful seasonal and LOCAL Squashes and Root Veggies, as well as everything else that is locally grown and produced. We have enough local storage veggies, such as Kale, Chard and Leek, to last until the end of the year – and all of those roots and tubers for the ongoing cold season. At our house, we have been making a feast of all kinds of coleslaws made with regular or napa cabbage, and adding shoots and sprouts. Satisfying and healthy!



Speaking of local Root Veggies, Dianne and her family from **Golden Acres Farm** just got done harvesting their Carrots, grown with lots of love, the old-fashioned way on a snowy day,

with plenty of back-bending and elbow grease, and thus bringing their harvest to a well-deserved finish. You will be seeing these absolutely tasty and crunchy Carrots (and those from other local sources) throughout the winter season in your Food Boxes. As every year, here is our **Holiday Delivery Schedule**, early enough for you to make any accommodations for the two weeks we're not delivering **> NO DELIVERIES the LAST WEEK of the year and the FIRST WEEK of the New Year.**

NO DELIVERIES December 26-28 and NO DELIVERIES January 2-4, 2022. Back for regular Deliveries Jan. 9-11, 2023

Let us know ahead about your own holiday plans and when you will not be home and will not need a delivery. As you know, you can log into your online profile and set up any Blackout Dates when you will not require a delivery. **Biweekly Customers**: You are just missing one delivery during one of the off-weeks and will receive your next one two weeks later according to your biweekly schedule.

Just in time for the festive season, we will be getting our last batch of **certified organic Turkeys**. Most of them are spoken for, but if you get in touch with us promptly, there may still be one for you. They will be frozen and we can therefore deliver them to you during our last delivery weeks before the holiday break – on December 12-14 or December 19-21. Of course, you can also pick up your Turkey at the Store if you prefer or live close by. The Store will be open until Saturday, December 24th at 1 p.m. and will reopen again for regular business on Thursday, January 5th, 2023.
