There will be **NO DELIVERIES the LAST WEEK of the year and the FIRST WEEK of the New Year**.

Please, mark the dates:

**NO DELIVERIES December 27-29
and NO DELIVERIES January 3-5, 2022.**

After the Holiday Break, we will be **back for regular deliveries on January 10-12, 2022**.

Let us know ahead about your own holiday plans and when you will not be home and will not need a delivery.

As you know, you can log into your online profile and set up any Blackout Dates when you will not require a delivery.

So we have just three more weeks of Food Box deliveries in the old year. **Thank you again for accommodating us for your early morning deliveries by allowing us access to your garage, enclosed porch, Florida room, shed, or by leaving out your heavy blankets, sleeping bags or coolers for us to safeguard your order.**
